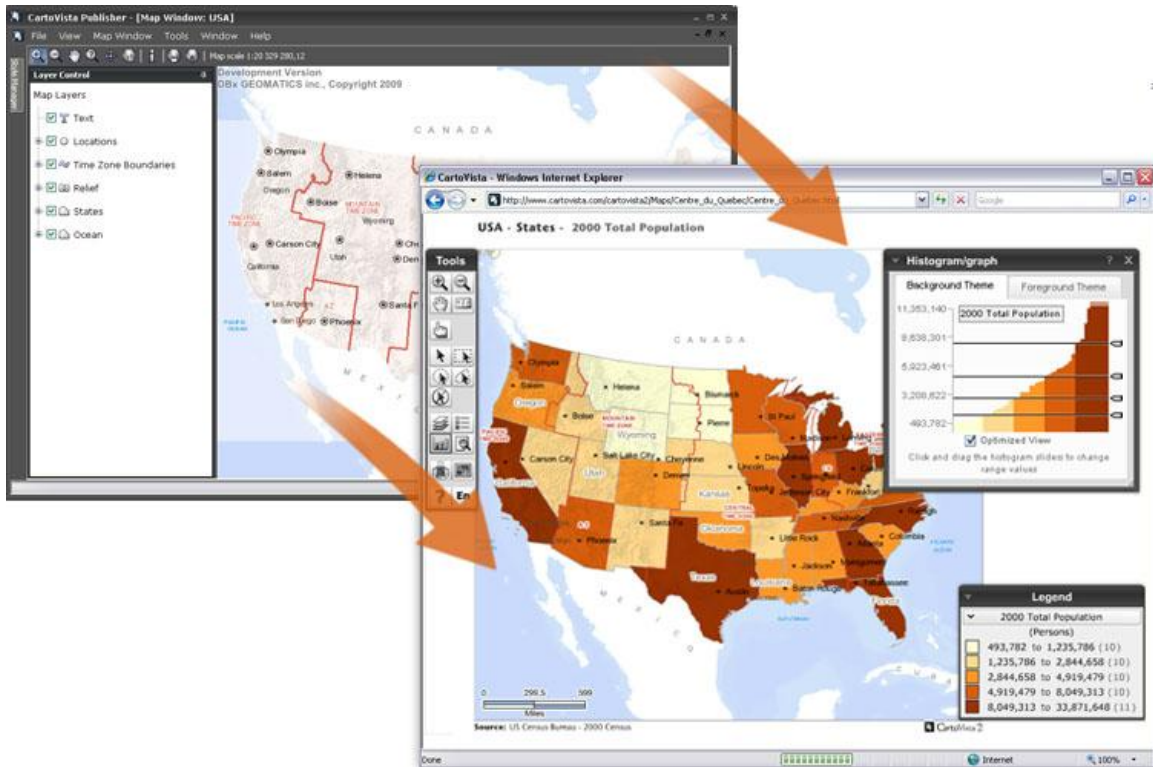

Quick Startup Guide

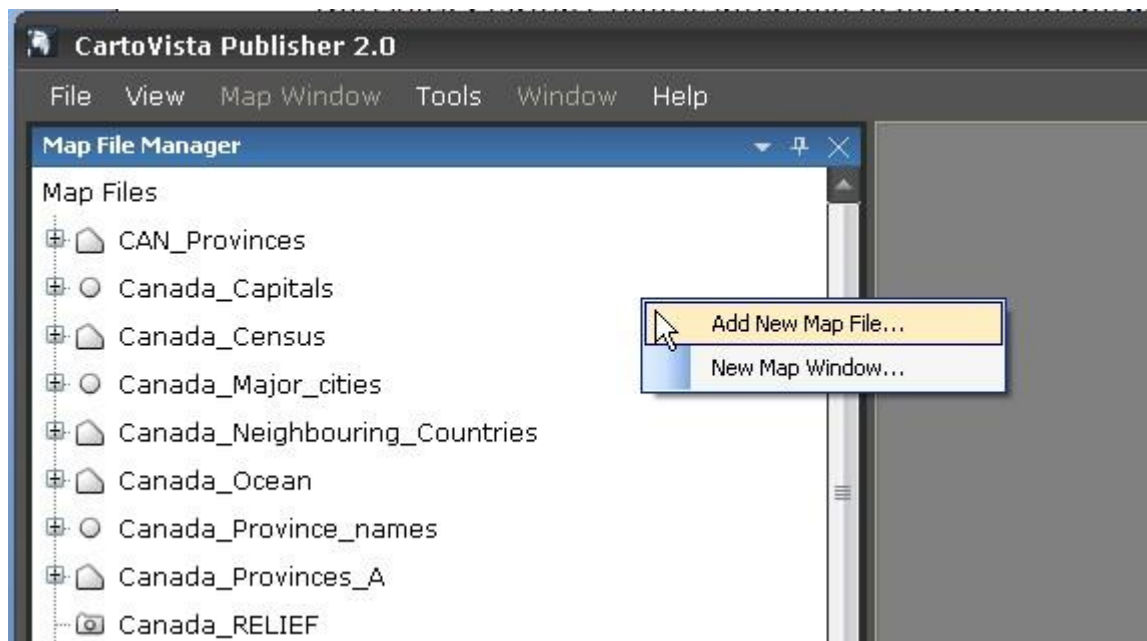
The purpose of the Quick Startup Guide is to go through the basic steps to setup and publish a map with the CartoVista Publisher. More detailed explanations are available in the CartoVista Publisher Help file. This example is based on the Canada sample data bundled with the CartoVista Publisher.

Create a Map

Map File Manager

In order to create a map, the user needs to go to the Map File Manager and has then two options:

- Use the current Map Files delivered with the CartoVista Publisher
- Add new Map Files from GIS data by right-clicking in the Map File Manager



Drag and Drop

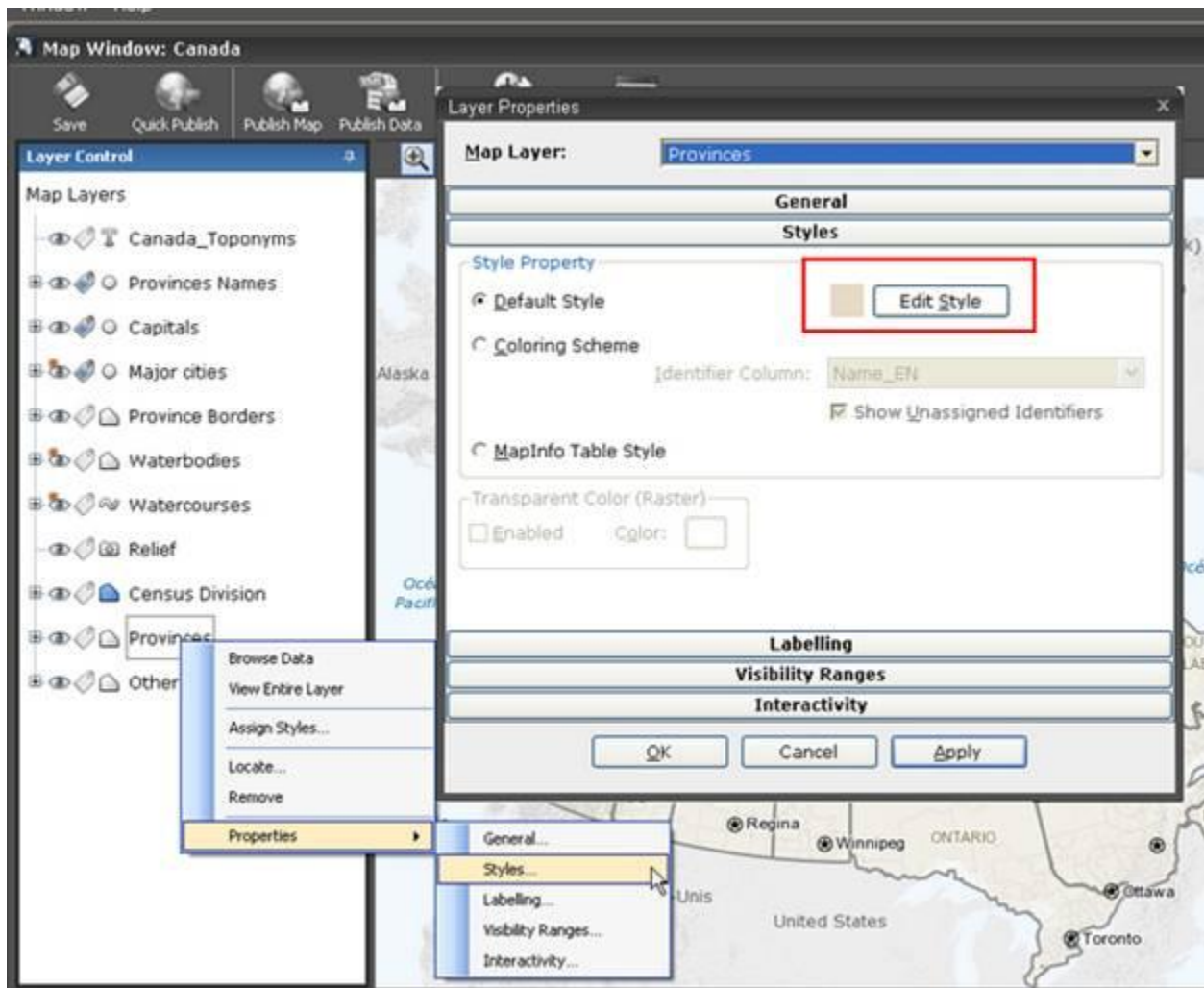
Dragging a map file and dropping it will open the map window and create the first map layer. Other layers can be added by dragging and dropping map files in the map window.

Styles and Settings

The style of each layer can be changed in the layer control. To access the layer style properties, the user can right-click on the layer and select ***Properties - > Styles*** and then click on "Edit Style". Other settings can be adjusted in the dialog by using other tabs.

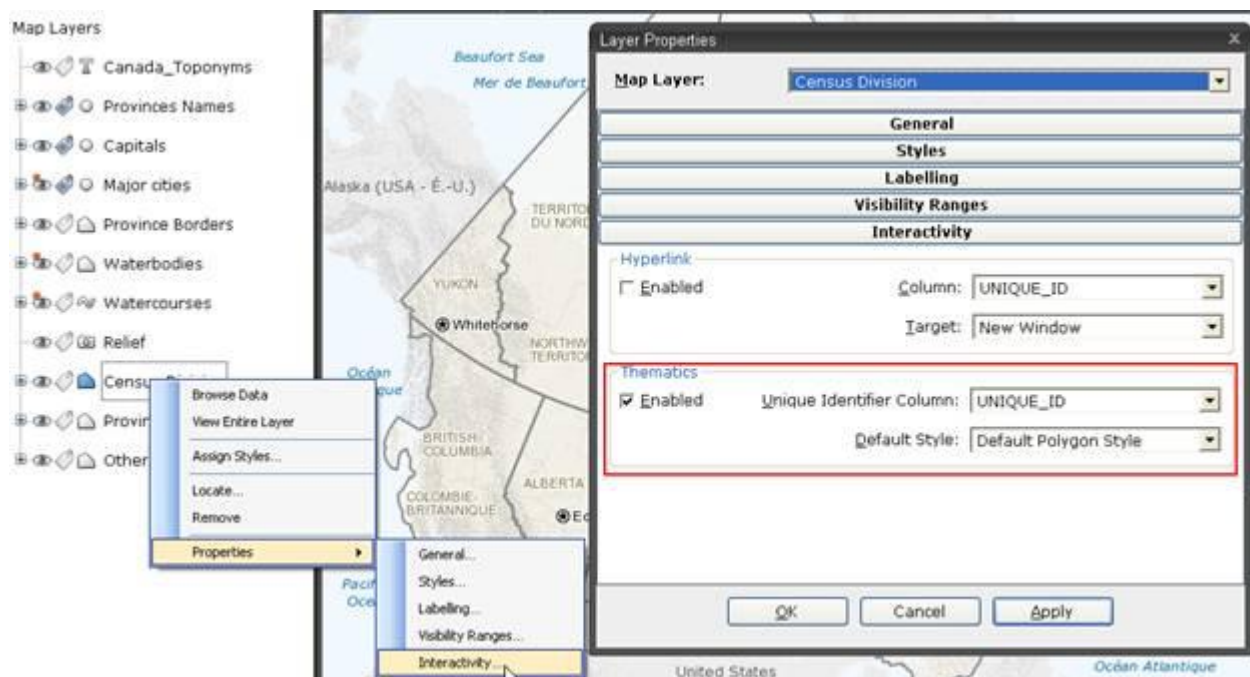


Thematic Map

To include a thematic on the interactive map, it is required to define which layer will be used and which column in the layer will represent the Unique Identifier. This will be done by selecting the Unique Identifier column in the Interactivity tab of the Layer Properties dialog. It is also necessary to check the box "Enabled". The next steps to publish a thematic map are to publish the map itself (in the .swf format) and the indicator data (see [Data Publishing](#)). Once the indicator data is linked with the swf map, the thematic can then be displayed in your web browser.

Note: If no layer is defined as a thematic layer, the map can still be published as an interactive map, but without thematics.

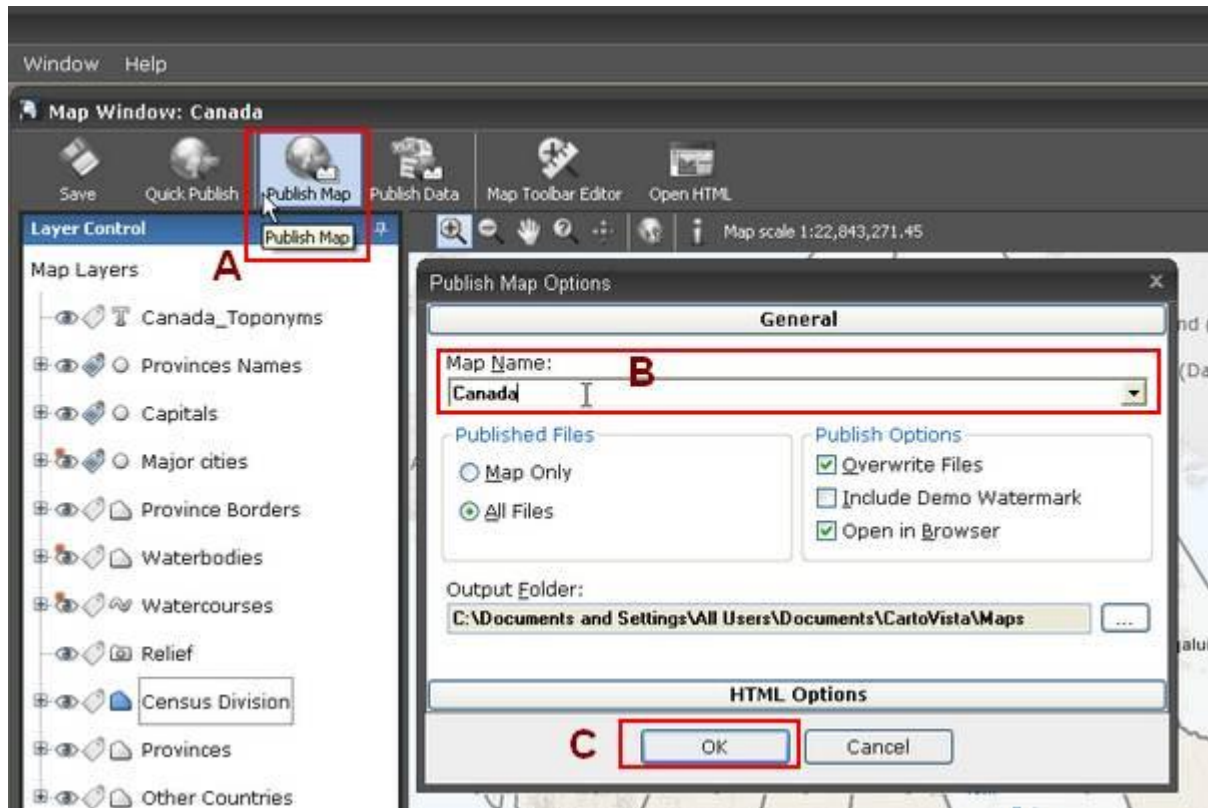

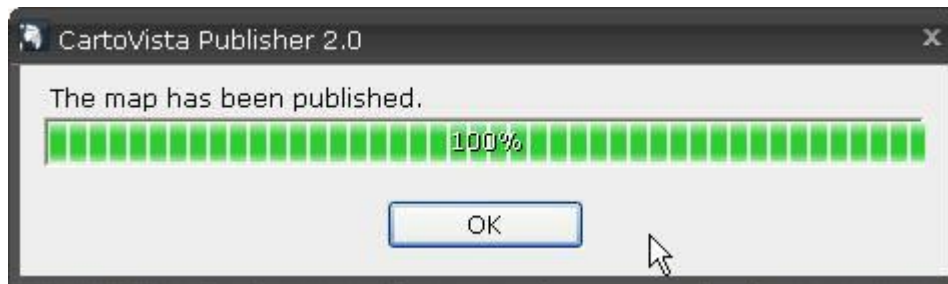
Publish a Map

Publishing a map is probably the easiest thing to do in the CartoVista Publisher.

- (A) Open the Publish Map dialog by clicking on the button in the map window
- (B) Enter a map name
- (C) Click on OK



Click on OK again when the map has been published. Your web browser will open, displaying the output map.



All map data will be published in the following directory:

C:\Documents and Settings\All Users\Documents\CartoVista\Maps\ <Map Name>

Data Publishing

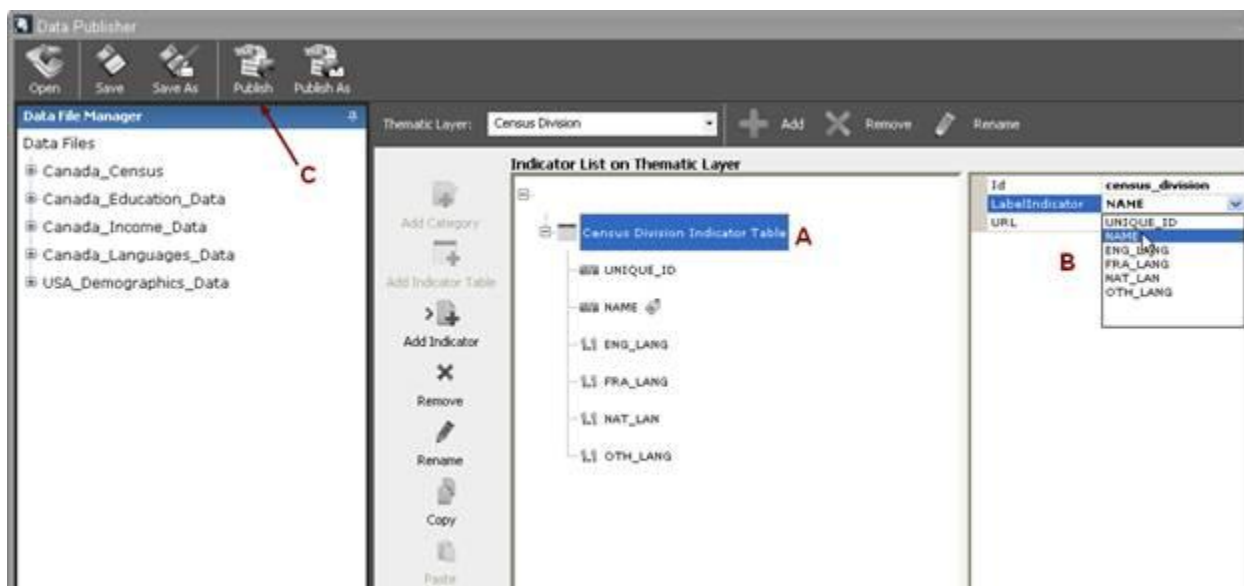
** These steps are valid only if a thematic has been applied on at least one of the map layer (Layer Properties Dialog – Interactivity Tab).**

From the map window, click on the "Publish Data" button.



The following steps are required:

- (A) Select the Indicator Table
- (B) Select the LabelIndicator by choosing an item from the drop down list in the right side panel
- (C) Click on "Publish"



Note: The user must include a LabelIndicator when publishing the interactive thematic map. This LabelIndicator will be displayed within the search tool; this label will also appear when mousing over every interactive object in the layer.

CartoVista Application

The process is now complete. To view the result of the map, click the "Open HTML" button from the tool bar.
